Entries open 7.00pm Wednesday 10 July 2024 and close on Monday 5 August at 10.00am.

- This event is run under **EA/FEI rules & regulations**. EA Jumping Rules 1 January 2024, FEI Jumping Rules 1 January 2024, EA (FEI) WC Rules 1 January 2024. Including the following:
 - a. FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse
 - b. EA Code of Conduct for Conflict of Interest
 - c. FEI Code of Conduct for Jumping Warm Up Arenas
 - d. EA Code of Conduct
 - e. Australian Helmet Standards
 - f. Age Rules including Junior and Young Rider
 - a. Amateur Rules
- All riders competing at the event will be deemed to have read and **accepted the Conditions of Entry**, as evidenced by ticking the Agree Box prior to completion of your entry on Global Entries Online.
- After any fall anywhere at SIEC, the rider must present to the Medical Services Provider to be cleared BEFORE re-mounting. A rider falling voluntarily ie jumping off, anywhere outside the competition arena does not have to report to the MSP. Art 224 2.
- 4 The OC reserves the right to change or amend the program at its discretion.
- 5 The OC reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry.
- All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their animals.
- 7 **Draw Order** Ring One with no exceptions at any stage will follow draw order. Should a horse need to be moved down the draw for exceptional reasons eg the loss of a shoe, the marshal shall communicate with the Judge to allow this.
- 8 All riders must be current financial full (includes Junior Classes) or participant members of EA.
- 9 All NSW registered riders must be current full financial members of Jumping NSW.
- 10 For any Young Horse Class an EA Jumping License must be purchased and the age rule of DOB of the horse will apply.
- 11 Number of Starts & Concurrent Classes:
 - a. A horse can only have two starts on any day
 - b. Where there are concurrent classes (as in an (a) and (b) section, a horse can only start in one section).
 - c. A rider may start in both sections of a concurrent class but on different horses.
 - d. Where there is a Junior section in any class if the rider meets the EA Junior rule the rider must ride in the Junior section of that class.
- Any person competing in a class, must have a registration in that class either via Global Entries Online or as a change of rider via the Office.

NOMINATION CONDITIONS CONTINUED

- 13 The OC reserves the right to swab horses.
- Refunds Refunds will be given in full before close of entries, less a \$50 administration fee, please contact the OC as refunds are not done automatically. After entries have closed, a 50% refund will be given on presentation of a veterinary or doctor's certificate.

15 Entry Changes

- a. Are allowed at no charge via Live Editing
- b. Will incur a \$10 fee if made outside Live Editing hours and must be made at the office.
- Incorrect Entries if an entry is incorrect at Close of Entries, an admin fee of \$25/ incorrect entry will be incurred. This includes incorrect horse/rider combinations.
- Presentation of Prizes Presentations in Ring 1 will always be mounted and riders are expected to wear their jackets. Ring 1 presentations winner and place getters must be present or have a representative in the Presentation. Presentations in other rings will be at the direction of the OC. Art 256, EA Jumping Rules, 1 January 2024
- 18 **Dress** Formal dress rules apply. Riders will be permitted to remove their jackets at the direction of the OC.
- 19 **Maximum number of starts per rider in a class** No rider will be permitted more than three entries (3 horses) in a class.

20 Dogs & Prams

- a. Dogs must be on a lead at all times
- b. Dogs are not allowed:
 - i. In the warm up arena
 - ii. Walking the course
 - iii In the Indoor or on the Concourse at any stage including passing through
- c. Prams are not allowed:
 - i. In the warm up arena
 - ii. Walking the course
- 21 **Protests** Must be addressed to the Ground Jury in writing and accompanied by a \$50 fee and can be lodged no later than 30 minutes after the announcement of the results of the relevant class.
- Young Horse Boot Rule Young Horse Boot Rule For any class or section of a class with an age requirement or limitation, the YH Boot Rule will apply includes Futurity Classes.
- 23 **GST** is included in all fees and charges, and prize money.
- 24 **Prize money** will be paid through Global Entries Online, please upload your banking details into your profile.
- 25 TSHA Thoroughbred Sport Horse Association Classes:

Horses must obtain a TSHA competition license to enter these classes. License is available on Global Entries Online (Manage Horses). Only horses with Thoroughbred Stud Book registration will be accepted. No part-bred Thoroughbreds.

Maximum height at longest point: 16 cm. Fastener: must be non-elastic Velcro with a minimum height of 5 cm.

Single shell boots with Velro-type fasteners

Maximum height at longest point: 20 cm. Velcro-type fastener may be elastic or nonelastic.
